## **2019** Santa Barbara County Duvarita Vineyard Pinot Noir

Duvarita is six miles from the Pacific Ocean, making it one of the closest to the ocean in Santa Barbara County. Biodynamically grown grapes, meticulous winemaking and a combination of two Dijon clones make a wine that captures both vintage and site.

## **Tasting Notes**

Blackberry and plum, turned earth, leather and musk fill the nose. Soft delicate dark fruit and fine tannin fill out the elegant palate.
